Evaluation Focussed on Distribution of Funding and Direct Benefits

More Systematic Approach: Situating Evaluation in the Policy Cycle

Broadening Focus of Evaluation to Wider Socio-Economic Impact





Key Drivers of Shift in Focus of EU R&I Evaluation

- Increased Focus on EU R&I Policy in Support of Growth and Competitiveness Agenda
- Increasing Need to Capture Wider Impacts of R&I to Demonstrate More Fully the Added Value of Public Funding
- Emergence of New Methodologies and Paradigms for Measuring the Impact of Support for R&I

Ex-Post Evaluation of FP7

- Going Beyond Evaluation of Direct Results to Assess Wider Economic and Societal Impact
- Use of Longitudinal Studies to Evaluate Longer-Term Impact of Framework Programmes
 - Contribution of Framework Programmes to Major Innovations
- Application of Counterfactual Analysis to Deepen Understanding of Effects of Involvement in Framework Programmes
 - Role and Impact of Industry Participation





Horizon 2020 Evaluation and Monitoring System

- Dedicated Indicators on Performance and Cross-Cutting Policy Issues
- Linked to Reporting on Major European R&I Policy Initiatives
- Application of New Methodologies
- High-Level External Input
- Involvement of Socio-Economic Actors





Policy Support Facility under Horizon 2020

- Facilitate Improved Design, Implementation and Evaluation of R&I Policies
- Make Expert Advice Available to Public Authorities on a Voluntary Basis
- Provision of Expertise and Guidance to Help EU Member States Implement R&I Reforms
 - enhanced peer reviews of R&I systems
 - tailored support to specific reforms
 - in-depth mutual learning on specific topics
 - online library of country and policy-relevant information





Research and Innovation Observatory (RIO)

- Set-Up to Provide World-Class Data, Analysis and Intelligence on R&I Policy and its Impacts at EU and National Levels
- Mission of Becoming a Globally-Recognised Observatory on European R&I Policy by:
 - Aggregating and Validating Data and Analyses from Different Sources
 - Building Networks of Stakeholders
 - Mobilising Relevant R&I Expertise and Competence in the Institutes of the European Commission's Joint Research Centre
- Key Elements of Remit Include:
 - Delivery of Statistical Data on Key Quantitative R&I Policy Indicators
 - Monitoring of and Development of Intelligence on R&I
 - Research on New Methods and Techniques to Measure, Monitor and Analyse R&I Policy
